



NOTE: Trail ratings are subjective depending on driver skill and other factors. Trail 7 is a quad/bike route that Rausch Creek Trail Riders run across the property. They start at the western end of Trail 11, come up H or the Power Line, across Tower Road, down the Pole Line and out A past the old office. If you see them running anywhere else or if they interfere with your group, get their helmet numbers and report the incident to the office.

Stay on the designated trail network by following arrows and signs, etc. Do not bushwack!

GREEN - Trails A through K, S, the Pole Lines and the Power Line are all Green.
Trail J is steep, one-way downhill, rutted, and off-camber

W	Trail 10 B, C	Green	Sections B and C: Logging roads and forest trail with some mud and rocks.
W	Trail 11	Green	Loops around the West valley, muddy, the western end is rutted out, look for bypasses or use 11-B
W	Trail 14	Green	Forest trail with rocks and mud.
E	101 Trail	Green	Forest trail, off-camber, optional "Hills" section (also serves as shortcut to the West property)

E	Trail 2	Blue	An excellent "club" trail with some GREEN bypasses. Rocks, gullies, FROG HOLE!
E	Trail 3 - upper	Blue	Off-camber with rocks. Offers access to middle portions of Trail 6.
E	Trail 4	Blue	Rocks, bowls, optional Yellow Jacket Ridge (BLUE-BLACK).
E	Trail 8	Blue-Black	Rocky with optional playground.
W	Trail 10 - A	Blue	Deeply rutted logging trails and forest trail. VERY DEEP MUD!!! MILK SHAKE!!! SMOOTHIE!!!
W	Trail 10-D	Blue	Loop trail connecting 13 with 10 with easy path across the Rock Creek.
W	Trail 12	Blue	Rocky, muddy forest trail. Rocky 1 st loop with GREEN bypasses, muddy 2 nd loop, rocky 3 rd loop.
W	Trail 13	Blue-Black	Very challenging rocky creekside trail w/ wash out areas.
W	Trail 15	Green-Blue	Logging road with some rocks. Optional "Water Hole" VERY DEEP!!!
W	Trail 18	Blue	Rocky trail. Optional BLACK loop on 2 nd section. Pizza Rock!

E	Trail 5	Black	Rockcrawling w/ steep hill. Optional 2 nd loop with extreme off-camber and bowls.
E	Trail 6	Black-Red	Rock ridge with extreme rocks and hillclimbs. SECTIONS C AND D ARE NOW PART OF COMP COURSE.
W	Trail 16	Black-Red	Spur trail located along Trail 13. Rockfield w/ sharp rocks.
W	Trail 17	Red	Hillside rockclimb
W	Trail 20	Black	Technical rocky trail running near and crossing over Trail 12. Pitman Rock!
W	Big Rocks	Black	A few large rocks next to Trail 10 trailhead.
E	Crawler Ridge	Black-Red	Large deposit of boulders located along Trails 2 and D. One track is BLUE-BLACK.
W	Rock Creek	Black-Red	A glacial deposit of rocks, stretching for about 1,800 feet, and over a hundred feet across.
E	The Heights	Black-Red	Rocky hillside along Trail 3 and behind the old office has obstacles such as Jotter's Way - Stairstep.
W	Otter's Trail	Red	Rock trail running between 13 and Rock Creek.

MULTI-LEVEL

1	Trail	Multi-Level	1-A is green w/ Winch Hill and black rock garden. 1-B is green. 1-C has steep hills and bowls (black)
E	CV Trail	Multi-Level	Located off Trail C, BLUE access loop with BLACK and RED hillside rockcrawling.
W	19	Multi-Level	GREEN with BLACK and RED hillside rockcrawling. 19-B is green but technical and rutted out.
W	Stout Trail	Multi-Level	Short GREEN loop, w/ separate picnic area. 2 nd loop BLACK rockcrawling.
E	"O"	Multi-Level	GREEN trail with RED hillside of rock crawling and BLACK sections at the bottom.
W	Power Line	Multi-Level	GREEN access road with playground near the top with puddles and steep off-camber short hills
E	Pole Line	Multi-Level	GREEN access road, rutted out, rocky, puddles, 5-foot Mud Hole

SOUTH PROPERTY Consists of a one-way green loop called "S Trail". Along the "S Trail" you will go past Tombstone (Black-Red), Boot Hill (black), Lake Christy (deep water and steep hills), Sunken Treasure (black), the Quarry, and Snakebite (blue-black and black). Stay on the designated trail network and do not drive through the food plots. Trail 21 is a technical green forest trail with optional black areas.

COMPETITION COURSE AREA behind office has natural and manmade obstacles. Check out the traction on the concrete, and obstacles such as the Gauntlet, Hot Tub, Mammoth Mtn and Big Rubber. Trails K and U3 (green) run through here.
